Role:

To coordinate, with the assistance of the police force, the closure of streets and to ensure that no vehicle access is permitted until after the event or if police inform otherwise.

Time commitment:

- Based on shift requirements
- Please be signed in and at information booth 15 minutes before your shift begins

Locations:

- Fulton and Main Street
- Mill Street and Martin Street
- Main and Brown Street

- Mill and James Street
- Charles and Mary Street
- Commercial and Pearl Street

Responsibilities:

- Sign in at Volunteer Centre prior to shift starting
- Review event map and identify exact location for barricade
- First shift is required to set up barricades as per training provided, last shift is required to take down barricades as per training provided
- Remain at barricade site until you are relieved by the next shift
- Do not allow any vehicles on the street, unless stated otherwise by police
- Feel free to bring a chair
- Sign out at Volunteer Centre at end of shift and return vest

Requirements & Qualifications:

- Must have good overall knowledge of the event and the location of specifics
- Must be 16 years of age or older
- Must have completed a Special Event orientation and training session

Dress:

- Volunteer t-shirt, hat, nametag, and dark bottoms (pants, walking shorts or capris), comfortable shoes/running shoes and orange vests (vest are provided)
- Reusable water bottle
