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### **Role:**

The Downtown Milton Street Festival is attempting to be an environmentally friendly event and volunteers are required to ensure that proper waste is going into the proper containers.

**Note:** If the blue bins are contaminated with any regular garbage, it will all go into the landfill. Volunteers need to ensure that recycling items are going into recycling bins.

### **Time commitment:**

- Based on shift requirements (two volunteers per sorting station)
- Please be signed in and at street location 15 minutes before your shift begins

### **Location:**

- In front of DBIA Office
- Main and James
- Knox Church Stage area

### **Responsibilities:**

- Sign in at Volunteer Centre prior to shift starting
- At assigned sorting station, monitor site cleanliness
- Place regular garbage and recycling in appropriate containers
- Monitor garbage levels and ensure bins are not overflowing
- Once containers are full, one volunteer will take the full container to the Downtown Business Improvement Area building (251 Main Street) and obtain an empty container
- Sign out at Volunteer Centre at end of shift

### **Requirements & Qualifications:**

- Must be 16 years of age or older
- Energetic people who are dedicated to the future ecology of our planet
- Must have completed a Special Event orientation and training session
- Must have completed recycling training from Region of Halton
- Must wear gloves and use claw as required

### **Dress:**

- Volunteer t-shirt, hat, nametag, and dark bottoms (pants, walking shorts or capris)
- Strongly recommend closed toe shoes (comfortable shoes/running shoes)
- Reusable water bottle
